REACHING THE UNREACHED

Dear Friends,

Greetings! You are being invited on a mission adventure that will change your life. Does that sound like a bold statement? Well, relax. We have it on good authority that this trip has been commissioned by the highest authority in the land (or any other land for that matter), the King of Kings. Over two thousand years ago, He commissioned every believer of every race and every generation throughout all time until He returns, to be about the Father's business of making disciples of all nations. Now it is your turn and your time.

This letter includes the preliminary details and enough information for you to start getting ready. Please read it very carefully, as this letter contains much information. It may not all apply to you. Please notice that you have several options to choose from. The entire trip is a little over three weeks, but you may choose to come for only one week. Please notice that each week has a different purpose, as well. As soon as we receive your completed trip application form, participation form, and application fee, we will take care of setting up all the other arrangements for you. Remember that check-in time for an international flight is at least two hours before scheduled departure.

Please understand that this is a mission trip. It is not a vacation or a leisure trip. You will be working very hard, and the accommodations may not be what you are used to at home. We ask you to accept whatever conditions confront you with grace, good humor and the love of Jesus. Your coming will be such a blessing to those to whom you minister. These brothers and sisters work in extremely difficult conditions and having a visit from Americans does so much to lift their burden and ease their sense of isolation. Just your presence reminds them that God has not forgotten their labor of love, and they are not alone.

As soon as we receive your application forms, along with the \$100.00/per person application fee, we will send you a more personalized package that will cover your part of the trip. It will include suggested items to take with you, some useful French phrases, general information about the country, suggestions on appropriate attire for both men and women, and some cultural do's and don'ts. You will also receive a projected ground itinerary, and what you will be doing each day.

OPTION 1 TRIP DATES: April 27-May 8, 2006. This option is open to anyone with an interest in Nigeria, West Africa. **Cost: \$2100.00**

OPTION 2 TRIP DATES: May 8-May 16, 2006 This option is open to anyone with an interest in Togo, West Africa. **Cost: \$2100.00**

OPTION 3 TRIP DATES: May 15-May 24, 2006. This option is for Medical and Dental Personnel and Assistants Only. The destination is Ghana, West Africa. **Cost: \$2600.00**

OPTION 4 TRIP DATES: April 27-May 24, 2006. Entire Trip. **Cost: \$3600.00**

TRIP COSTS: The above listed costs include non-refundable application fee per person, roundtrip airfare from Orlando, lodging, food, and ground transportation in your country of destination.

DEADLINES: **IMMEDIATELY apply for passport if you do not already have one.** [Application forms may be obtained at the Post Office. You will need two passport size photos which may be obtained at Wal Mart. It often takes six weeks to receive passports.]

MARCH 1ST: \$100.00 Non-Refundable Application fee

This application fee covers our costs in setting the trip up for you (mailing calls to West Africa, and many other logistical necessities.) We incur these expenses even if you decide later not to go.

MARCH 15TH: Make appointment with your healthcare provider to receive all shots and malaria prophylaxis

APRIL 1ST: \$1500.00 AIR FARE (PER PERSON)

This is a close approximation based on prices we have right now. The earlier you secure your ticket, the greater the guarantee you have to lock it at this price. With oil prices rising, we cannot guarantee this price until you have actually paid for it. The longer you wait the more chance that this price may go up. You may pay for your ticket any time before this date, but April 1st is the deadline.

APRIL 8TH: VISA FEES (Approximately \$50.00)

By this date, your passport and the visa fees must be in the AOF office. *This fee is not included in your total package, as they vary from country to country.* AOF will then send all passport and visa fees to the embassy of your country of destination. An application for a visa to your country of destination will be in the information packet that will be sent to you after we receive your completed application form and fee. If you sign up for the entire trip, you will need visas for all three countries, and each country has separate fees.

APRIL 22ND: Remainder of fees

The costs listed in this letter do not include the following:

Passport

Visas

Immunizations

Souvenirs or personal items

The above fees must be received in the AOF office by the stated dates. Checks should be made payable to AOF Missions, Inc.
