REACHING THE UNREACHED



May 1, 2006

Greetings everyone. We arrived safely in Jos on Saturday. In true African fashion, Apostle Godson put us to work right away. He had scheduled a special meeting at his church for Saturday night. He had each of the young people share for 5 minutes and then had me teach. I had an opportunity to share with him the Master Builder Plan that we have been working on at Church of the Great Commission as we sat at the airport for 4 hours Saturday morning waiting for our flight. Apostle Godson felt that this teaching was just what his church needed at this time. The Church in Africa is plagued with the same malady that the Church in America is. There is much running and seeking of big crusades and programs, but very little quiet work of real discipleship. There is far more of "come and hear" than "go and tell" if that going and telling involves the hard work of raising world-visionary, world-impacting, reproducing disciple-makers.

So Saturday night I shared a message on discipleship and disciple-making based on the Master Builder Plan. Then Sunday morning we turned the service into a "lab" with those who had been at the teaching the night before helping to share a discipleship message with those who were not there. Paul and the girls are doing an awesome job of sharing their testimonies and relating to the people. Bro. Godson says the people are receiving a lot from us and are giving him good feedback. However, I never try to assess the "success" of a trip, until we see if fruit is produced. To me success is not measured by the size of a crowd or the numbers that respond to an altar call. Success is measured by those who are producing fruit a year later. That is why we rely so heavily on partnerships with national pastors that we know share our same vision and will help cultivate the seed we have planted after we are gone.

Sunday after church, Paul and the girls went with members of Godson's household to the well to learn how to draw water. They are practicing carrying it on their heads, much to the amusement of the entire community.
